All participants are required to submit two (2) passport sized photos along with the application. Please write down the name and position at the event (i.e. contestant, accompanied parents, instructor/leader or otherwise) on the back of the photos.
- Contestant can enter into a higher level of competition and are not allowed to enter into lower categories than they are currently at. AIAMA reserves the rights to disqualify the contestant and reclaim any losses if the judges discover that any contestant has entered at a lower level than permitted.

 - Select six (6) contestants with highest scores from Group Olympic to participate in Abacus Olympiad Competition
 - **Award Distribution:** The contestant with the highest scores (40% in Group Olympic scores, 60% in Abacus Olympiad Competition scores) will be crowned as The AbacusKing in this Abacus Olympiad Competition.
 - In the event of tie, a winner will be determined based on marks obtained from Multiplication, Division, Addition and Subtraction, Bills Calculation and Mental Arithmetic. If a tie still remains, the younger contestant will be the winner. However, if the winner's point is lower than 300 of this competition, the AbacusKing in 2018 will not be awarded.
- iii. The AbacusKing 2018 will be awarded The Highest Honor AbacusKing Sash, cash prize MYR300 (Malaysia Ringgit, Malaysia currency), and Certificate of Achievement by the President of AIAMA.

15. FURTHER EXPLANATIONS

- i. Multiplication, Division with Abacus and Mental Arithmetic is 5 points each question, Addition and Subtraction is 10 points each question.
- ii. If the total points of the contestant is lower than one hundred and twenty (120), no prize or trophy will be awarded.
- iii. Judging criteria, written answers, mistakes corrections and others will be determined by AIAMA judge panel. No objections should be raised against the decision of AIAMA judges panel.
- iv. Strictly obey the stopping announcement: Contestant must stop writing immediately and flip over the test paper, upon hearing the stopping announcement. The question paper will be attached with a red card, if the examiners catch the contestant disobeying the stop announcement and the marks of this contestant will be subject to deduction. (20 points per paper or 30 points if it's mental arithmetic)

16. EVENING BANQUET PERFORMANCE

- i. All the teams need to prepare a performance of 3 to 5 minutes for the evening banquet to showcase their skills. Please provide the name of the performance together with the application form.
